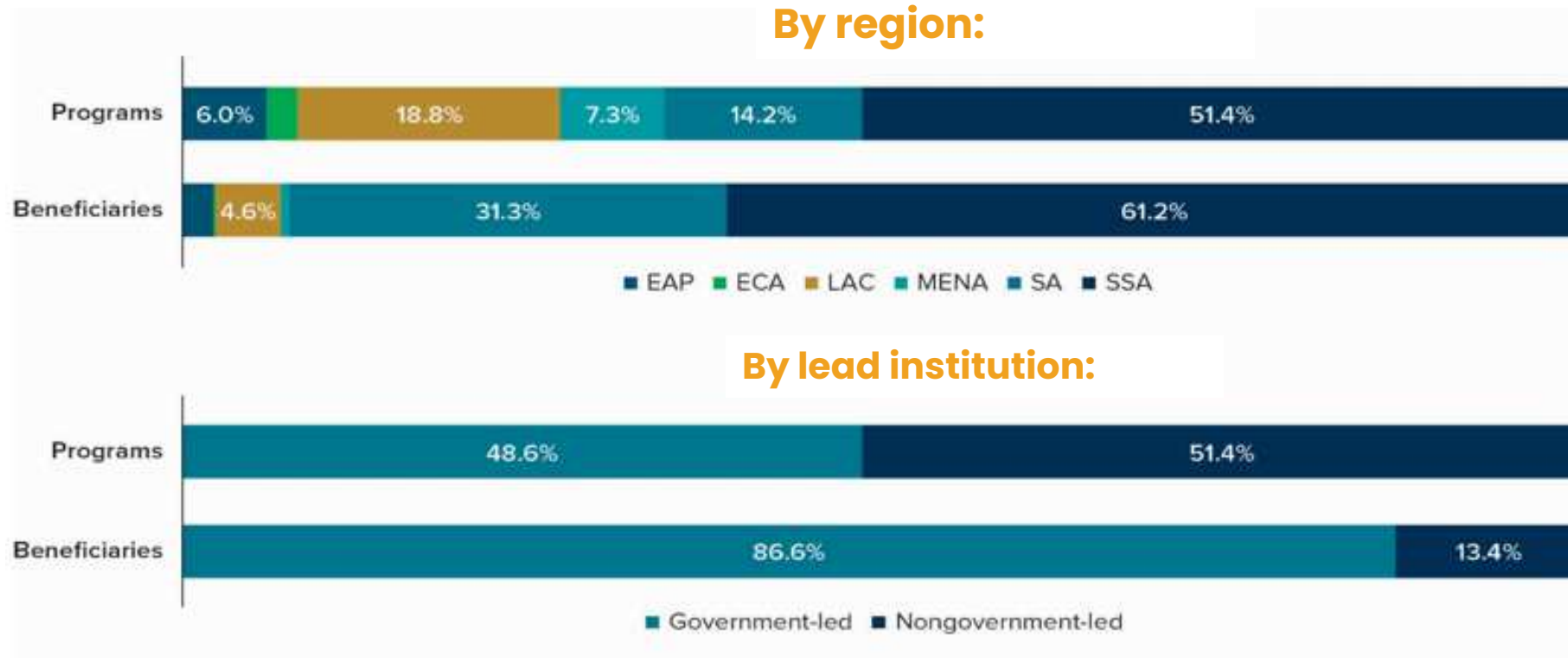
Three important messages

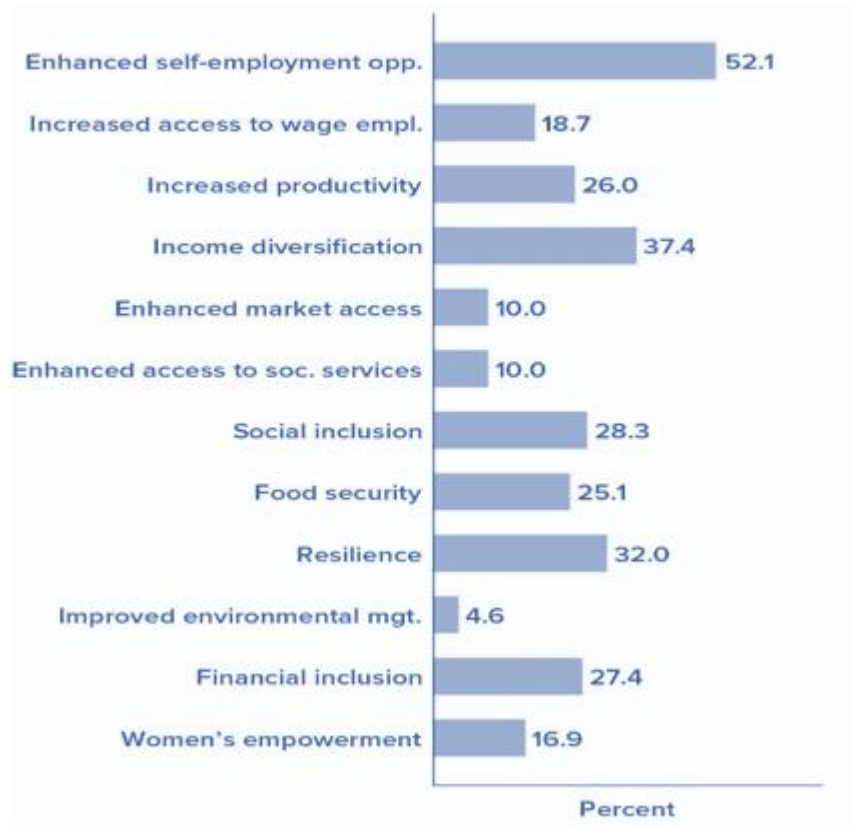




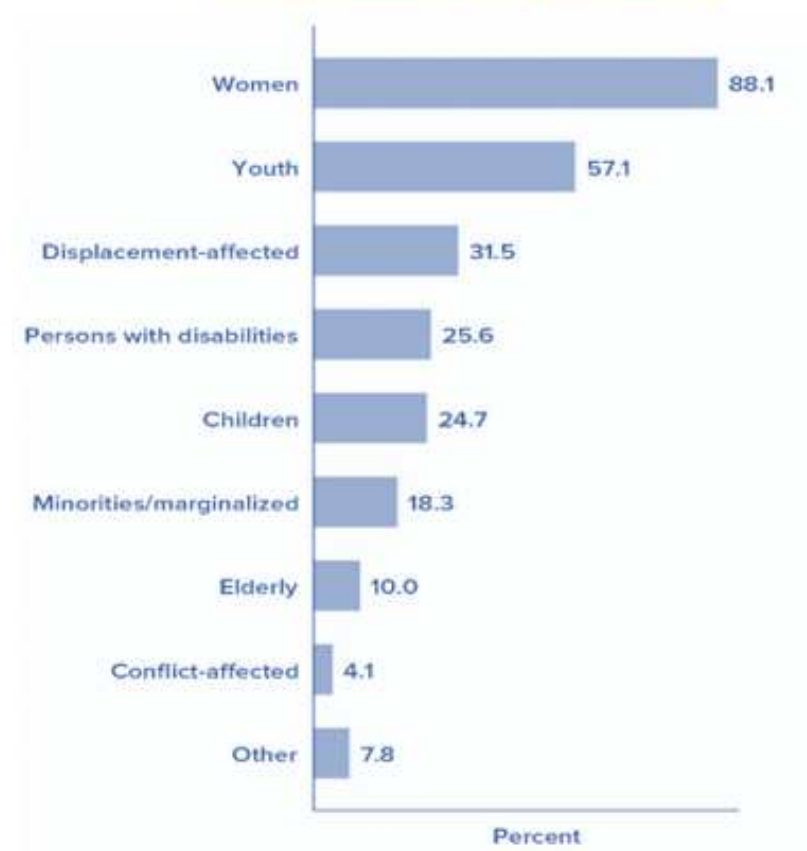

Dimension of scale	Focus	Description	Expected Results
Increased coverage	Programmatic Aspects	Including more people and/or communities (...)	Improve, widen, and/or deepen program outcomes
Functional expansion		Increased scope of activities, program linkages and referrals	
Policy and strategy	Institutional Aspects	Reinforced by legal and budget provision	Improve efficiency; improve fiscal and policy coherence
Organizational		Coordination at different levels, within and outside of government	
Operational		Building delivery systems, linking to existing platforms
